



Andrzej Sołdek, Board Member of Skarbiec TFI

Andrzej Sołdek graduated from Warsaw School of Economics with an M.A. degree in International Trade (1996). In 2000 he took part in the Strategic Management course at Institute for Management Development in Switzerland. He is a licensed stockbroker (1992), investment advisor (1994) and Chartered Financial Analyst® (2004). From the beginning of his career, he has worked within the financial sector. He gained his experience in ING Group, where he was a stockbroker for DM Banku Śląskiego SA (1992-1995), investment advisor at ING BSK AM SA and Board Member, CIO at ING BSK AM SA (1996-1998). From 1998 on, he was part of Zurich PTE SA, where he took senior management positions (CEO, CFO, CIO) and was responsible for finance, accounting, controlling, investment and increasing market share. In 2003 he began working for PTE PZU SA, where he was deputy CEO and CIO (2003-2008), and in the years 2008-2016 he held the position of CEO and at the same time CIO (2014-2016). His main responsibilities included PTE PZU SA's strategy, investment activity and fund accounting (OFE, DFE) as well as PTE, legal advice, compliance, internal audit, risk management. From 1 July to 19 December 2018 he was vice-president of Skarbiec Holding SA and from 1 July 2018 Board Member of Skarbiec TFI SA. In the years 2003-2005 he was a member of supervisory board of the following companies: W. Kruk SA, Polfa Kutno SA, and Elektrobudowa SA (2003-2004) and in the years 2017-2018: Elektrobudowy SA, Ferro SA, Skarbiec Holding SA and Tarczyński SA.
